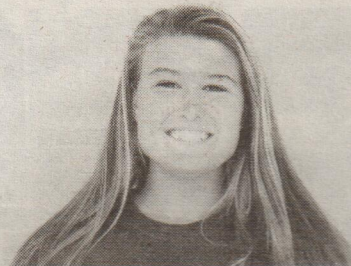
Tinkham, Stoner Take Highest Honors
