



#### "MyFit + Roadmap" Introduction



How does a high school student-athlete get recruited by a university that fits best:

"ACADEMICALLY - ATHLETICALLY - NON-ATHLETICALLY - SOCIALLY/CULTURALLY???"

"MyFit + RoadMap" is designed to remove any confusion and completely empower the dedicated high school student-athlete of any level or sport, who has a serious desire to be an NCAA D1, D2, or D3 college student-athlete. "MyFit + RoadMap" is a unique and proven system which is a comprehensive, yet easy to follow, approach to inexpensively and effectively guide the student-athlete to successfully achieving three specific main goals:

Goal #1: to discover a university which best fits the student-athlete personally,

Goal #2: to be successfully recruited as a student-athlete by that university,

Goal #3: to obtain meaningful financial support (athletic scholarship/financial aid) to attend that university.

To achieve the above three goals "MyFit + RoadMap" has three basic, yet essential, personalized components for ultimate success:

Component 1: "MyFit" "Top 10" NCAA D1 Universities (see tabs 3 and 4)

Component 2: "MyFit" "Select/Dream 10" NCAA D1, D2, and D3 Universities (see tabs 5 and 6)

In Component 2: This second list are the "Select/Dream 10" universities identified by the student-athlete, and scored by "MyFit" as to how well each of those "Select/Dream 10" universities fit the student-athlete personally (see tab 5).

Additionally in Components 1 and 2: The student-athlete is provided with a "MyFit" University Info Sheet/Follow-up Diary (see tabs 4 and 6) for each "MyFit" scored university with detailed athletic and non-athletic specific information. The "MyFit" University Info Sheet/Follow-up Diary enables the student-athlete detailed assessment of each of their "MyFit" scored universities, and formatted for accurate factual side-by-side comparison between "MyFit" scored universities.

In Component 3: The student-athlete is provided with a customized step-by-step "RoadMap" (see tab 7), which guides them through the NCAA requirements and critical tasks. These requirements and tasks need to be followed and completed on a compliant and timely basis over the student-athlete's 50 months of high school. This timed schedule best enables the student-athlete to keep completely organized and on track to successfully achieving the three specific main goals of "MyFit + RoadMap".





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
